MOVING SOUTH AFRICA TO A BETTER TOMORROW

2011 October Transport Month (OTM) Programme, an annual opportunity to focus the attention of the country on issues of transport, has been unveiled.

Transport is a means to move goods and people from point A to point B in a safe, efficient, affordable and sustainable manner.

OTM this year focuses on job-creation and service delivery. In the 2011/12 financial year 68 675 jobs will be created through the S'hamba Sonke Roads Programme. This ring-fenced conditional grant will focus on the following areas:

- Fixing potholes on our roads
- Creating access to schools and clinics and other public facilities
- The rehabilitation of key arterial routes that support the rural economy through labour intensive projects
- Prioritising the use of labour absorptive systems, including a "know your network programme".

Furthermore, OTM 2011 will highlight road safety in South Africa, seeking to find common solutions to the harrowing deaths that occur so frequently on our roads.

According to social development minister Bathabile Dlamini, the inter-ministerial committee on alcohol and substance abuse has established a technical team tasked with developing policy proposals and strategies for addressing, amongst other things, the possibility of strengthening existing regulations dealing with public drinking and driving under the influence of alcohol.

The legal limits on alcohol for drivers are contained in **National Road Traffic Act 93 of 1996**.
