HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT, 1974 (ACT NO.56 OF 1974)

REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION BY ENVIRONMENTAL
HEALTH PRACTITIONERS OF ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

The Minister of Health intends, under section 35 (2) of the Health Professions Act, 1974 (Act No. 56 of 1974) and after consultation with the Health Professions Council of South Africa, to make the regulations in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE**Definitions**

1. In these regulations, and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear such meaning, unless the context otherwise indicates.
