## **HEALTH PROFESSIONS ACT, 1974 (ACT NO.56 OF 1974)**

# REGULATIONS RELATING TO THE QUALIFICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION OF MEDICAL ORTHOTISTS AND PROSTHETISTS.

#### **SCHEDULE**

#### **Definitions**

- In these regulations, and any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Act shall bear such meaning, unless the context indicates otherwise-
  - "the regulations" means Regulations relating to the qualifications for the registration of Medical Orthotist and Prosthetist as published under Government Notice R. 398 in *Government Gazette No.* 35366 of 21 May 2012.

### Qualification for registration

2. The registrar must register as a Medical Orthotist and Prosthetist any person who is in possession of the following qualifications: -

#### Repeal

 The Rules for the Registration of Medical Orthotists and Prosthetists as published under Government Notice No. R. 58 in Regulation Gazette No. 4306 of 13 January 1989 are hereby repealed.

#### **Short title**

4. These Regulations are called Regulations Relating to the Qualifications for Registration of Medical Orthotists and Prosthetists, 2022.
