NOTICE OF THE CONCLUSION OF A SUNSET REVIEW INVESTIGATION OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTIES ON CLEAR FLOAT GLASS OF A THICKNESS OF 2.5 MM OR MORE BUT NOT EXCEEDING 6 MM DIVIDED INTO 3 MM, 4 MM, 5 MM AND 6 MM THICKNESSES, ORIGINATING IN OR IMPORTED FROM THE KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA (“SAUDI ARABIA”) AND THE UNITED ARAB EMIRATES (“UAE” OR THE “EMIRATES”)

The International Trade Administration Commission of South Africa (“the Commission”) conducted a sunset review investigation of the anti-dumping duties on clear float glass of a thickness of 2.5 mm or more but not exceeding 6 mm divided into 3 mm, 4 mm, 5 mm and 6 mm thicknesses, originating in or imported from Saudi Arabia and the Emirates.

The investigation was initiated after the Commission considered that there was *prima facie* evidence that there would be a likelihood of the recurrence of dumping and material injury should the anti-dumping duties expire. The Notice of initiation was published in Notice No. 2984 of 2025 in *Government Gazette* No. 52029. All known interested parties were notified of the initiation of the investigation.

After considering comments to essential facts letters, the Commission made a final determination that the expiry of the anti-dumping duties on the subject products originating in or imported from Saudi Arabia and the Emirates would likely lead to the recurrence of dumping and material injury, and therefore decided to recommend to the Minister of Trade, Industry and Competition that the current anti-dumping duties on clear float glass of a thickness of 2.5 mm or more but not exceeding 6 mm divided into 3 mm, 4 mm, 5 mm and 6 mm thicknesses be maintained as per Report No. 755.
