NOTICE IN TERMS OF SECTION 40(2) OF THE LABOUR RELATIONS ACT, 1995: FISHERS' STATUTORY COUNCIL

I, **Lehlohonolo Molefe**, Registrar of Labour Relations, do hereby in terms of section 40(1) read with section 39 of the Labour Relations Act, 1995 establish the statutory council for the following sectors:

Fishers employed to work on a South African flagged fishing vessel legally operating in a fishing sector in terms of the Marine Living Resources Act No. 18 of 1998 as amended that is not regulated by another Bargaining or Statutory Council.

In the following areas:

- (a) South Coast Rock Lobster
- (b) West Coast Rock Lobster (off-shore)
- (c) Longline (Hake)
- (d) Small Pelagic (Sardine & Anchovy)
- (e) Large Pelagic (Tuna)

I also publish a notice in terms of section 40(2)(a and b) inviting registered trade unions and registered employers' organisations in the sectors mentioned above and any interested parties in the same sectors to attend a meeting to nominate representatives for the statutory council.

Registered trade unions and registered employers' organisations and any interested party should indicate their interest to the office of the Registrar of Labour Relations: Department of Employment and Labour not later than 21 days from the date of publication of this Notice.
