## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS TO FILL VACANCIES ON THE BOARD OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN HEALTH PRODUCTS REGULATORY AUTHORITY (SAHPRA)

The SAHPRA Board was established in terms of the Medicines and Related Substances Act, 1965 (Act No. 101 of 1965) as amended, for the purpose of monitoring, evaluation, regulation, investigation, inspection, registration and control of medicines, Scheduled substances, clinical trials and medical devices, IVDs and related matters in the public interest.

The Honourable Minister of Health, Dr MJ Phaahla, invites the public to submit nominations of candidates to be considered for appointment to the Board of the SAHPRA to serve for the unexpired term of office ending on 30 **September 2024** with expertise in the fields **of Medical devices**, **IVD**, **Vigilance and Public Health or Epidemiology**.

**Disqualification from membership of the Board:** A person **shall not** be appointed as Director/ Board member if that person: -

- (a) is not a South African citizen and ordinarily resident in the Republic;
- (b) is an unrehabilitated insolvent;
- (c) has at any time been convicted of an offence involving dishonesty, whether in the Republic or elsewhere, and sentenced to imprisonment without the option of a fine; or
- (d) has been removed from an office of trust.

**Remuneration:** Remuneration for Board meetings is set at the level prescribed by the National Treasury. It should be noted that employees of National, Provincial and Local Government, Government agencies or entities, appointed as members on the SAHPRA Board, are not entitled to additional remuneration, and will not be remunerated for their service as members of the Board. Members of the Board will not serve in full-time capacity and it is envisaged that the Board meetings will be held on a quarterly basis.

**Requirements of a valid nomination**: Nominations must be made on a nomination form obtainable from the Department of Health's website at <u>www.health.gov.za</u> under **VACANCIES**. A comprehensive Curriculum Vitae (CV) of the nominee should be attached, including certified copies of academic qualifications and supporting information.
