NOTICE OF NERSA'S PUBLICATION AND PUBLIC HEARING ON THE ELECTRICITY TARIFF APPLICATION FOR CITY POWER (SOC) LTD FOR PURPOSES OF REDETERMINING THE 2024/25 FINANCIAL YEAR TARIFFS

The National Energy Regulator of South Africa (NERSA) is a regulatory authority established as a juristic person in terms of section 3 of the National Energy Regulator Act, 2004 (Act No. 40 of 2004). NERSA's mandate is to regulate the electricity, piped-gas and petroleum pipelines industries in terms of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), the Gas Act, 2001 (Act No. 48 of 2001) and the Petroleum Pipelines Act, 2003 (Act No. 60 of 2003).

On 14 January 2026, the High Court of South Africa, Gauteng Division, Pretoria reviewed and set aside the NERSA approved 2024/2025 Municipal tariffs for City Power (SOC) Ltd, ordering the licensee to resubmit compliant tariff application and cost of supply study and directing NERSA to redetermine the tariffs by no later than 30 June 2026.

NERSA has published the tariff application, including the cost of supply study on the NERSA website, social media platforms and newspapers to solicit written comments from affected parties. The notice will be published in two (2) official languages.

The indicative timeline for the decision-making process in relation to the abovementioned tariff application is provided in **Table 1 below**.

5. Public Hearing on the tariff application (Virtual Public Hearing - Microsoft Teams)	20 May 2026 Time: 13H00 - 14H30
6. NERSA's Regulator Executive Committee (REC) to consider Reasons for Decision on the tariff application	09 June 2026
7. Communication of NERSA's decision to the affected municipality and key stakeholders	18 June 2026

NERSA's decision will be made, taking into account all written and oral comments from the affected and interested stakeholders.
