of Transporters of Waste for Gain

I, Nonkqubela Pieters, Member of Executive Council for the Department of Economic Development, Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEDEAT) in the Eastern Cape hereby in terms of sections 25(1) of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 Of 2008), give notice of my intention to request persons who transport waste for gain to register with the Provincial Waste Management Officer in the Department, as set out in the Schedule hereto.

Transporters of waste for gain are invited to register, within 90 days from the date of publication of this notice in the Government *Gazette*, to any of the following addresses:

REGISTRATION OF TRANSPORTERS OF WASTE FOR GAIN IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 25(1) OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT: WASTE ACT, 2008 (ACT No. 59 OF 2008)

Definition

1. In this Notice, unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression that is defined in the National Management Waste Act, 2008 (Act No. 59 of 2008) and associated regulations, shall have the meaning **so assigned**—
" Act " means the National Environmental Management: Waste Act, 2008.
"Department" means the Department of Economic Development, Environmental Affairs and Tourism.

Purpose

2. The purpose of this Notice is to-
 - (a) Prescribe the manner in which a person transporting waste for gain in the Eastern Cape Province must register
 - (b) Ensure vehicles used for the transportation of waste are appropriate for the task, to prevent harm to environmental and human health and wellbeing
 - (c) encourage the use of waste manifest system through information submitted in the Application Form for Transporters of Waste for gain, attached as Annexure 1 in this Notice.

General

3.
 - (a) Any person who currently transports waste for gain, must within ninety (90) days of publication of this Notice apply for registration using the prescribed application form obtainable from the Department.
 - (b) Any new person who wishes to transport waste for gain, after coming into effect of this Notice, must within thirty (30) days of being established, apply for registration using the prescribed application form obtainable from the Department.
 - (c) The Department must consider all registration application forms with all sections correctly completed, within thirty (30) days of receipt and issue a registration certificate
 - (d) A registered person must notify the Department of any change in respect of that person's registration certificate within



thirty (30) days of such change occurring, after which an amendment will be effected.
(e) This Notice shall not apply to municipal waste collection vehicles.

Offences and penalties

4. (1) A person commits an offence if that person-
 - (a) Fails to apply for registration in terms of this Notice
 - (b) Intentionally provides incorrect or misleading information to the Department
- (2) A person convicted of an offence in terms of subsection 4(1) above is liable to-
 - (a) an appropriate fine
 - (b) imprisonment for a period not exceeding 15 years
 - (c) both fine and imprisonment

Short Title and commencement

This Notice is called the Registration of Waste Transporters for Gain, 2025, and takes effect from the date of Publication in the Government Gazette.
