DRAFT NOTICE DECLARING THE BETTY'S BAY MARINE PROTECTED AREA UNDER SECTION 22A OF THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT: PROTECTED AREAS ACT, 2003 (ACT NO. 57 OF 2003)

I, Bomo Edith Edna Molewa, Minister of Environmental Affairs, hereby publish for public comment, the intention to withdraw the existing Betty's Bay Marine Protected Area under section 22B, and to declare under section 22A of the National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act, 2003 (Act No. 57 of 2003), the Betty's Bay Marine Protected Area as set out in the Schedule hereto.

Any person who wishes to submit representations or comments in connection with the proposed declaration is invited to do so within 60 days from the date of publication in the *Government Gazette* and by no later than 16h00 on the last day. Comments received after this time may not be considered. All geographic co-ordinates are determined in accordance with the WGS 84 datum, and all bearings are true bearings.

Boundaries of the Marine Protected Area

The Betty's Bay Marine Protected Area in the Western Cape Province is bounded by, as the western boundary, a line (180° true bearing) drawn from the beacon marked B1 (34°22.450'S; 18°53.765'E) situated at Stony Point, as the eastern boundary, a line (180° true bearing) drawn from the beacon marked B4 (34°21.357'S; 18°56.240'E) situated to the east of "Jock-se-baai", as the southern boundary the latitude 34°24.450'S, and as the northern boundary, the high-water mark.

Purpose for declaring the Marine Protected Area

The purpose of declaring this Marine Protected Area is to:

- (1) protect and conserve the marine and coastal ecosystems and marine and coastal biodiversity that are found in and around Betty's Bay;
- (2) protect the reproductive capacity of exploited species of fish, including linefish species, shellfish such as abalone *Haliotis midae*, and West Coast Rock Lobster *Jasus Ialandii*, to allow their populations to recover and to contribute to the replenishment of adjacent areas; and
- restrict or prohibit activities which are likely to have an adverse effect on the environment including the African penguin and bird colony situated at Stoney Point.

Withdrawal of the Betty's Bay marine protected area

The declaration of the Betty's Bay marine protected area as contained in stipulation 2(2) of the declaration notice named Declaration of Areas as Marine Protected Areas in *Government Gazette* 219487, Notice No. 1429 of 29 December 2000 is hereby withdrawn and repealed.
