INVITATION FOR NOMINATIONS OF PERSONS TO SERVE ON THE BOARD OF THE ROAD ACCIDENT FUND (RAF)

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT HEREBY CALLS FOR NOMINATIONS OF SUITABLY QUALIFIED PERSONS TO SERVE AS NON-EXECUTIVE DIRECTORS ON THE BOARD OF THE ROAD ACCIDENT FUND (RAF) FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS.

(NB. Persons who previously applied to the Advert issued in need not reapply as their applications will still be considered)

The RAF is a Schedule 3A State-Owned Enterprise listed in terms of the PFMA Act No.1 of 1999, (as amended) and is established by the Road Accident Fund Act No. 56 of 1996 (as amended) ("RAF Act"). The RAF is responsible for providing appropriate cover to all road users within the borders of South Africa; rehabilitating and compensating persons injured due to motor vehicles in a timely and caring manner; and actively promoting the safe use of all South African roads. The object of the Fund shall be the payment of compensation in accordance with this Act for loss or damage wrongfully caused by the driving of a motor vehicle".

The RAF has a Board of Directors appointed by the Minister of Transport in accordance with section 10(1)(b) of the RAF Act (as amended) who comprise independent, non-executive members possessing extensive qualifications, skills, experience and expertise to exercise strategic authority and governance control over the Fund to ensure it delivers on its mandate.

Members of the public are hereby invited to nominate persons with the requisite industry expertise and knowledge as well as skills and experience in the fields below, with an understanding of the RAF's mandate and operations and who possess experience serving as a Non-Executive Director on Boards.

NB. People of all races are encouraged to apply.

- **Insurance:** incl. insurance law/ underwriting/short-term insurance/insurance schemes.
- **Law:** incl. legal, compliance, risk, medico-legal.
- **Accounting:** CA SA with extensive experience in claims and insurance related environment or other Industrial experience.
- **Actuarial Science:** professionally registered actuary with experience in data analysis and modelling.
- **Medical Services:** registered medical practitioners with governance and administration experience in the corporate sector and matters relating to disabled persons, road users, commuters' or consumers' interests.
- **IT Specialist:** Registration with the accredited bodies will be an advantage.
- **Governance Specialist:** leadership position in the Public Service and Private sector will also be an advantage.

Nominations must contain the following:

- Nominator's full names and address with signed acceptance of nomination by the Nominee.
- Certified ID copy of the Nominee and must include the following: Full names, Gender, Race; Age, physical address, telephone numbers and e-mail address
- CV to list other Board membership(s): Prior and Current as well as prior and current relevant expertise, quoting dates and organisations concerned
- Certified copies of Academic qualifications.
