# DEFINITIONS

1. In these regulations "the Regulations" means the regulations published as *Government Notice 1114* in *Government Gazette No. 36041* of 28 December 2012 as amended as-

Government Notice 564 in Government Gazette, No. 37840 dated 18 July 2014; Government Notices 625 and 626 in Government Gazette, No. 37910 dated 13 August 2014; Government Notice 235 in Government Gazette, No. 38589 dated 20 March 2015; Government Notice No. 1162 in Government Gazette, Vol.605, No. 39435 dated 20 November 2015; Government Notices No.1495 in Government Gazette, No. 40472 dated 2 December 2016.

Regulation 4, Sub regulation 4B(Id): is hereby amended by -

- 1. Deletion of :
  - (a) Learners offering Physical Sciences [and Accounting] as one [or more] of their optional subjects selected from <u>Group B</u> in the policy document, *National policy Pertaining to the Programme and Promotion Requirements of the National Curriculum Statement Grades R 12*; must offer Mathematics as a compulsory subject selected from <u>Group A</u> in the said policy document.
